We identified a problem, got ideas to solve the problem, designed a solution, carried out the solution, evaluated the solution, and shared the results with our class. Ask your child about his/her team's solution.

<u>Science</u>: We are very excited by our work with Sound! We're using our senses to observe sound systems as they make sound. We're asking the questions - What do I see moving? What do I feel? What do I hear?
