And Dismissal

We will dismiss on the playground as usual during the COLD months and students may often have outside recess. Please remember this when making decisions about clothes, socks/shoes, and coats in the morning!!!

Spelling: Next week's spelling words are printed on the back to save paper.

<u>Math</u>: Our work with cube **arrays** (for example, 3 rows of 5 cubes equals 15 cubes) is laying the foundation for multiplication. We are not memorizing multiplication tables (like I did in school when I was this age!). We are working on understanding the concept of multiplication and quick recall of multiplication facts will come later.

Reading: Our read aloud, An Amazing Octopus, by Patricia Lauber gave us a chance to talk about main idea and supporting details. Our shared reading about ants will allow us to learn more about text organization and non-fiction text features. We will find the main ideas and look for supporting details as we read. This work will help us discover how authors organize their writing.

<u>Writing</u>: We read <u>When I Was Little</u>: A Four Year Olds Memoir of Her Youth, by Jamie Lee Curtis. **Such a cute story!** Please talk with your child about a few things from when he/she was little. This week we are practicing retell and plot summary. Then we will follow the plot of this Jamie Lee Curtis story to create a story of our own.

Science: Soon, I will be sending home information about inventing an instrument at home to share with the class. If you have not had a chance to read the Magic School Bus book, <u>Inside the Haunted House</u>, you may want to check it out. It could give you some ideas. This week we are discussing the sound starter, as well as what makes the sound.
