It's time to **SPRING** forward! Be sure to set your clocks ahead 1 hour on Sunday, March 11<sup>th</sup>.

Please remember we are accepting used books that are in good condition for the Used Book Fair.

**Spelling:** You'll find next weeks' Spelling List on the back.

<u>Math</u>: We just finished the test for unit 8 and we are getting ready to begin unit 9. In unit 9 we will be measuring around shapes to get the pe<u>rimeter and we will measure the "stuff" in the middle using centimeter and inch grid paper to find the area. Gallons, quarts, and pints along with liters help us measure capacity.</u>

**Reading:** Ask your students about their AR goals for this last trimester. Encourage them to stay focused and read, read! They have their three goals again: points, percent correct and book level. If you have any questions let me know.

Tomorrow is Dr. Seuss' birthday. Students can bring Dr. Seuss books and a blanket or pillow.

<u>Writing</u>: To make our writing less repetitious, we're learning how to combine sentences. Sentences with "like" (similar) verbs can be combined easily. For example: Mrs. Strohfus is a teacher. And Ms. Reed is a teacher. Can easily be combined into...Mrs. Strohfus and Ms. Reed are teachers. This week we are writing Personal Narratives (a story that's "all about me"), again. This time it's about an adventure with a friend.

<u>Social Studies:</u> Next, we'll talk about how to read maps of our communities and explore map keys (and what they tell us) along with discovering the compass rose that points to north, south, east, and west. Ask your child about what we see when we look toward the west in Denver.
