

Spelling: You'll find next weeks' Spelling List on the back.

Math: We are about halfway through Unit 9 and we will be taking the end of unit test very soon. Please be sure to help your child with all homework from unit 9 so that he or she will be well prepared for our test! We will continue our work with perimeter and area. Many students still need to work on telling time to the nearest quarter hour, knowing how much change will be given when paying with \$1, recognizing equivalent fractions, basic addition and subtraction facts, as well as two digit addition and subtraction.

<u>Reading</u>: In reading this week, we have been learning more about events in sequence. In addition, we continue to work on making three reasonable predictions, identifying main idea and details, summarizing both fiction and non-fiction stories, and identifying author's purpose.

<u>Writing</u>: We continued our work on our personal narratives from last week. Last week, we started a story about ourselves having an adventure with a friend.

Social Studies: We have spent the week learning more about maps and how they help us. As well as, learning about map grids and why they are useful.
